



French National Suzuki Summer music course 2020

23- 28 August 2020, Carroz d'Arâches, Haute-Savoie

This course is open to all Suzuki students of the **violin, cello, or piano** from beginner to advanced, and **viola (books 1 to 3)**. Families enrolling a child must be members of the AFPS, or of a foreign national Suzuki association.

This course aims to provide children with a joyful experience of playing their instrument, in a welcoming family environment. It is an

opportunity to review known pieces, while also getting to know other teachers, and taking part in new workshops. In short, it is the perfect opportunity to boost students' motivation and meet new friends -- through music -- at the end of the summer holidays.

Option for violin, viola, cello : INDIVIDUAL LESSONS

One-hour lessons, in the form of a MASTERCLASS, for 2 or 3 students according to level. Each student (and parent) will take part in successive individual lessons, with all other participants observing to enrich their knowledge and understanding. All participants remain for the entire class.

The workshop will be scheduled at two points throughout the week:

Students in Books 1-3 : 3 children per class, 20-minutes lesson per student

Students in Book 4 + : 2 children per class, 30-minutes lesson per student

Option for violinists, violists, and cellists : rehearsal with piano accompaniment

Individual session of 20 or 30 minutes with the accompanist. The student is free to choose whichever pieces(s) he would like to practice with the pianist.

Spaces are limited, and will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Book 5 and more

1 group lesson on the digital keyboard
1 individual lesson - 45'
1 other ensemble class: group lesson, orchestra, duet, or trio
1 Body Percussion class

Teachers reserve the right to choose the most appropriate course of study for each student.

Option for pianists, from Book 3 and higher: Duets / Trios (please contact us in advance)

If a student is selected for the orchestra, or for the keyboard ensemble, (s)he can opt for a duet / trio activity instead. This is a 30-minute class for 2 or 3 children on an upright piano, and the piece will be chosen from outside the traditional Suzuki repertoire. You must be able to read music for this class.

ACCOMMODATION FEES

Accommodation is provided with **full board**, including all meals (from dinner on Sunday August 23rd through breakfast on Friday August 28th). Afternoon snacks are not included. A picnic lunch will be available for order on Friday, August 28th (on site).

"Les Flocons Verts" center offers rooms and split-level "duplexes" for 3 to 8 persons, equipped with bathrooms and a kitchenette. Two families sharing the same duplex will nonetheless be housed on separate levels, with separate bathrooms.

People with disabilities, and families with a child under the age of 3 will be given priority in terms of un-shared accommodation, subject to availability.

You may free to choose the family with whom you would like to share a duplex.

Bed-linens, duvets, pillows, and bath towels will be provided.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Registration is open **only** to students studying their instrument year-round in the Suzuki method, with a teacher recognized by the ESA.

BOOKINGS :

Registration will be confirmed only on proof of membership to the AFPS. (Register online at: www.afpedagogiesuzuki.fr). Registrations are conducted online, and on a first come first serve basis. A non-refundable deposit of €100 per student is required at the time of online registration. Registration will be deemed confirmed only upon receipt of full fee.

Minimum level: 1 full year of study

All participants, French or foreign, must be members of the AFPS or another national Suzuki association. Students under the age of 18 and registered for the course must either be under the full responsibility of an adult who will also be present at the course, or registered at "Camp Ados Suzuki."

Telephone bookings will not accepted.

IN CASE OF CANCELLATION

Deposits are non-refundable. Requests for cancellation received prior to **June 30, 2020** will be refunded with a 20% penalty. **No refund will be made after this date.**
