


French National Suzuki Summer music course 2024

20- 25 August 2024, Carroz d'Arâches, Haute-Savoie

This course is open to all Suzuki students who play **violin**, **cello**, or **piano** from beginner to advanced, and **viola** (**books 1 to 4**). Families enrolling a child must be members of the AFPS, or of a foreign national Suzuki association.



This course aims to provide children with a joyful experience of playing their instrument, in a welcoming family environment. It is an opportunity to review known pieces, while also getting to know other teachers, and taking part in new workshops. In short, it is the perfect opportunity to boost students' motivation and meet new friends -- through music -- at the end of the summer holidays.

Book 3 and higher: Teachers will plan an appropriate course of study, according to the number of advanced students registered. Teachers reserve the right to choose the most appropriate course of study for each student.

Free Option for all students: Solo Concert

A solo recital is organized every day, as well as a piano rehearsal. The child will be able to perform in public, from memory and accompanied by the pianist. The piece must be chosen in agreement with the teacher, fully studied with him and should be well practiced during the summer.

ACCOMMODATION FEES

Accommodation is provided with **full board**, including all meals (from dinner on Tuesday August 20th through breakfast on Sunday August 25th). Afternoon snacks are not included. A picnic lunch will be available for order on Sunday, August 25th (on site).

"Les Flocons Verts" center offers rooms and split-level "duplexes" for 3 to 8 persons, equipped with bathrooms and a kitchenette. Two families will share the same duplex and will nonetheless be housed on separate levels, with separate bathrooms.

People with disabilities, and families with a child under the age of 3 will be given priority in terms of un-shared accommodation, subject to availability.

You may free to choose the family with whom you would like to share a duplex.

Bed-linens, duvets, pillows, and bath towels will be provided.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

- Registration is **only** open to students studying their instrument year-round in the Suzuki method, with a teacher recognized by the ESA.
- Minimum level: 1 full year of study
- All foreign students must be members of their national Suzuki association.
- Students under the age of 14 registered for the course must be under the full responsibility of an adult present at the course. Teenagers between 14 and 17 years old can come without their parents by registering for "Camp Suzuki Ados". No additional cost.
- Registrations are only conducted online, and on a first come first serve basis.
- Registration is validated after receipt of the deposit. The invoice will be sent by email after payment of the deposit.
- Closing date for registrations: June 30, 2024

IN CASE OF CANCELLATION

In case of cancellation of the course on our part: the expenses paid will be fully refunded.

In case of cancellation by the customer:

- The deposit, administration fees and bank charges are not refundable.
- By validating the registration, the customer undertakes to pay all fees before **June 30th**, **2024**.
- After 30th June 2024, fees will be due, except in very special cases.

No refund will be possible after this date.
